- · Spring sports are doing great
 - Softball ECC Champs, and had Defensive Player of the Year (Meghan McClellan), and Coach of the Year (Christy Gregory)
 - Girls LAX set school record of 12 wins, and made it to the Regional Semi-Finals for the first time in school history
 - Boys LAX 2nd in ECC, made it to the Regional Semi-Finals for only the third time in school history, had Offensive Player of the Year (Luke Barkimer)
 - Boys Tennis 2nd in ECC, had ECC Player of the Year (Jaden Worden), Coach of the Year (Michael Neverman), and a doubles team qualified for Districts
 - Track and Field had 3 state qualifiers in 3 separate events: Caitlin Evans (Long Jump), Daniel
 Walker (Discus), & Elle Campbell (1600m Run), and the girls team finished 2nd in ECC as a team
 - School record of 40 college signings for Class of 2024
 - Summer youth camps served over 1200 kids
 - Milford Athletic Alumni Foundation has submitted paperwork for approval and meetings are underway to meet with local high school alumni departments to learn their procedures/processes/systems - hoping to have a kickoff event this fall to announce the start of this organization
 - Planning a Meranda Sports Complex grand opening and Ed Morris Wrestling Room dedication with alumni at the end of July
 - Working on a new track & field / cross country school records board to replace what was lost during demolition of stadium – will provide estimate at August board meeting
